E-Discovery for the Modern Litigator

E-Discovery is the discovery of electronically stored information ("ESI"). ESI includes all information stored in an electronic medium, including emails, text messages, voicemails, and metadata. E-Discovery arises in the context of litigation whereby a party may obtain the discovery of ESI from another party or non-party in an effort to obtain relevant information.
